Sample Office Visit Codes As Determined by the Complexity of Each Office Visit as well as Carrier-Specific Billing Guidelines

92000 CODES (Eye Codes)

- 92002 or 92004 – NEW PATIENTS
- 92012 or 92014 – ESTABLISHED PATIENTS

Or...

E & M (Evaluation and Management)

- 99000 CODES (E/M: Office Visit Codes)

On a return visit, if there is an *established medical necessity*, you can use the appropriate CPT codes as follows with an established patient:

- 92012-92014
- 99211-99215

* Be sure to examine for DRY EYE. There is a strong correlation between dry eye symptoms and CVS. Check with your local carrier regarding information on punctal occlusion procedures and punctal plugs.
